Hi All

We've had two capture events recently of Salvin's Albatross, one auto-liner and one trawler, on the C/Rise.

Both vessels were maintaining best practice procedures at the time, and in both cases it was a 'one-off' Trigger-point' capture event; rather than vessel/crew poor performance..

This is the highest risk bird as per 'level two Risk assessment'/ NOPA, for the deepwater fleet, and one in which we are working hard to reduce the risk of multiple capture events.

This is the period we see increased encounters and some years aggressive behaviour as adults feed chicks.

Please be vigilant in your mitigation deployment and ensure best practice and or VMP offal control procedures are strictly followed.
